NO.	ISSUES RAISED	CA'S RESPONSE
1.	In a situation where the owner of the approved content by KICD (OEM) who is also the owner of the IP is not going to submit a bid and has instead given authorization to another firm to submit the bid on their behalf, would this be admissible?	The structure of the tender did not envisage a situation whereby the owner of the approved content will transfer the approval to another firm. In addition, under Section II – Tender Data Sheet – the document does not allow for Joint Venture. It is only the firms whose content has undergone Curation, verification and KICD Council approval that will be admitted for evaluation.
2.	In view of the immense amount of work required to put the documents together and in view of the fact that responses to clarifications are yet to be issued, we request that you extend the tender closing date by an extra 14 days.	The digital content has undergone all the necessary approval process – Curation, Verification and KICD Council approval. All that is remaining is to meet the requirements of the tender document and submit for evaluation. The request for extension of the tender closing date by an extra 14 days has been declined
