RE: OPEN NATIONAL RE-TENDER FOR UPGRADE OF THE HYBRID SOLAR SYSTEM AT CA REMOTE STATIONS

Please refer to the above-mentioned tender.

Pursuant to ITT 9.1 of the tender document shared with bidders, the Authority wishes to respond to the clarifications sought out as follows:

NO.	CLARIFICATION QUESTIONS	CA RESPONSE
1.	“We refer to the mandatory requirement No.14 for bidders to hold an EPRA Class C1 Electrical Contractor Licence. We seek clarification on this requirement in light of Regulation 6 the Energy (Solar Photovoltaic Systems) Regulations, 2012, which, among other things, specify the licensing requirements for solar PV System Contractors. Regulation 6 specifically mandates that entities undertaking the design and installation of solar PV systems hold a Class C1 Solar PV Contractor Licence issued by EPRA.	The Authority clarifies that "Class C1 Solar PV Contractor Licence" is also allowed. The mandatory requirement shall now be either of the two C1 license
2.	SOLAR PV MODULES (13) Manufacturer warranty At least 12 years.	The Authority clarifies that the Manufacturer warranty of the solar PV modules is amended 2 years.
3.	On whether it is mandatory to bid for all six project sites? If not, what is the maximum and minimum number of sites one can bid on.	Please refer to the tender document Part E on the Award Criteria
4.	Whether there a specific implementation time period for each site	Please refer to the tender document Evaluation Criteria B (Technical Compliance) item A of the compliance table.

ALL other conditions of the initial tender remain unchanged.
