



DOT KE LICENCE

LICENCE TERMS

The Communications Authority of Kenya (hereinafter referred to as the “**Authority**”), in accordance with the Kenya Information & Communications Act, Cap 411A (the “**Act**”), hereby authorises “**the Licensee**” to provide DOT KE Country Code Top Level Domain (CCTLD) Sub-Domain Registrar services, hereinafter referred to as the “**Licensed Services**” in the Republic of Kenya in accordance with the Terms and Conditions set out in this license.

1. The authorisation attracts annual operating fee of Kenya shillings ten thousand (10,000/=) only.
2. The Licensee shall:
 - 2.1 provide the Licensed Services by utilising telecommunication facilities of licensed network facilities providers or where necessary first obtain the relevant licence/s before installing and operating private telecommunication systems to facilitate the provision of the Licensed Services;
 - 2.2 ensure that all equipment or devices used to provide the Licensed Services are type approved by the Authority;
 - 2.3 ensure that its equipment, facilities, systems or operations do not interfere or harm third party property or installations due to licensee’s operations and the licensee shall render harmless services or compensate those third parties that may suffer damage;
 - 2.4 ensure that all information that it may obtain in the course of providing the Licensed Services is treated in confidence and shall not be divulged or disclosed to any third party without the client’s or the Authority’s written consent;
 - 2.5 provide information to the Authority in respect of the Licensed Services at intervals as may be required by the Authority from time to time, and
 - 2.6 not enter into contracts with third parties that will prejudice the interests of the Authority or/and other Licensee.
 - 2.7 not assign, delegate, transfer or encumber in any manner the rights, interests or obligations under this Licence without the prior, express and written consent of the Authority, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld or delayed.
3. The Communications Authority:
 - 3.1 may terminate this Authorisation in accordance with the Kenya Information & Communications Act.
 - 3.2 reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions of this Authorisation in accordance with the Kenya Information & Communications Act.

This Certificate shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with the Act.
