

PUBLIC NOTICE

RENEWAL OF RADIO COMMUNICATION LICENCES

The Communications Commission of Kenya (CCK) wishes to remind all licensed frequency users that all radio frequency transmitters must be operated under an annual licence which must be kept in force at all times through regular payment of the prescribed licence fees and adherence to other licence conditions.

These requirements apply to the following:

- Radiocommunications services by public fixed and mobile cellular operators
- Private fixed and mobile radio networks
- Television (TV) and radio broadcasting transmitters
- Maritime and aeronautical radiocommunications networks
- Satellite-based radiocommunications Services
- Amateur Radio services
- Radio alarm services

In accordance with the *Kenya Communications Act, 1998*, and the *Kenya Communications (Amendment) Act, 2009*, operation of radio services without a licence is an offence that attracts a fine of Kshs 5 million or an imprisonment of a term not exceeding three years or both. This penalty applies to operation of additional radios/alarms other than those authorized in the licence.

The deadline for renewing frequency licences is 1st July every year. This notice does not apply to domestic radio and TV receivers.
